Angela Snyder attended as representative from the Town of St Joe the Indiana Finance Authority to be able to apply for State Revolving Funds.


Randy Drake motioned to approve of hiring Amanda. Zebulon Griggs seconded the motion. All ayes


Mary Simcox found her binder from the 2018 meeting she attended for the comprehensive plan workshop she gave to the town board for review to complete and update the current comprehensive plan.


ADJOURN:
