Zebulon Griggs motioned to accept the appreciation report. Misty Spicer second that motion. All ayes cast.

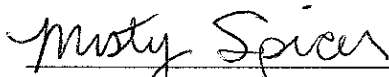
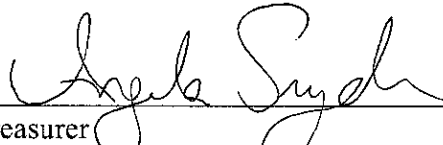
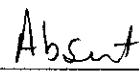
