Protecting Our Drinking Water Starts with Proper Disposal!

Certain household materials like paints, chemicals, automotive fluids, and batteries, can contaminate soil and groundwater. **Keep these materials out of the regular trash!**

Hazardous materials not accepted during Clean Up Day can be disposed of through the:

Northeast Indiana Solid Waste Management District (NISWMD)

- Automotive fluids
- Cleaning fluids & drain cleaners
- Pool chemicals
- Fertilizers & weed killers
- Asphalt sealer & roofing tar
- TVs & monitors
- Computers & laptops
- Printers & small electronics
- Lead-acid batteries
- Rechargeable batteries

Disposal fees apply based on material type and load size; cash or check only (no cards).
